### Intended Participants:

This class is designed for all automotive instructors who want to increase their knowledge of the selected topics, improve their teaching techniques and diagnostic skills, and to meet their NATEF training requirements.

### Topics:

OBD II Diagnostics: Includes Drive Cycles and Monitors, Making Sense of MODE 6, and Evaporative Emission Systems. The week will include approximately fifteen hours of extensive hands-on assignments that include testing and diagnosing a variety of vehicles.

### Cost: ( Subject to change once the State Budget is approved):

Each student must register for 1.5 units, forty hours of college credit, and the cost is \$43 for residents (Non-Resident fees are \$276 for 1.5 units, plus \$30 Enrollment Fee, \$13 student fees, so the total cost is \$319.00).

Materials (Binders and Book), refreshments, and lunches will be paid for by a variety of industry sponsors. This is approximately a \$200 savings per person, so take advantage of this excellent opportunity and enroll early.
